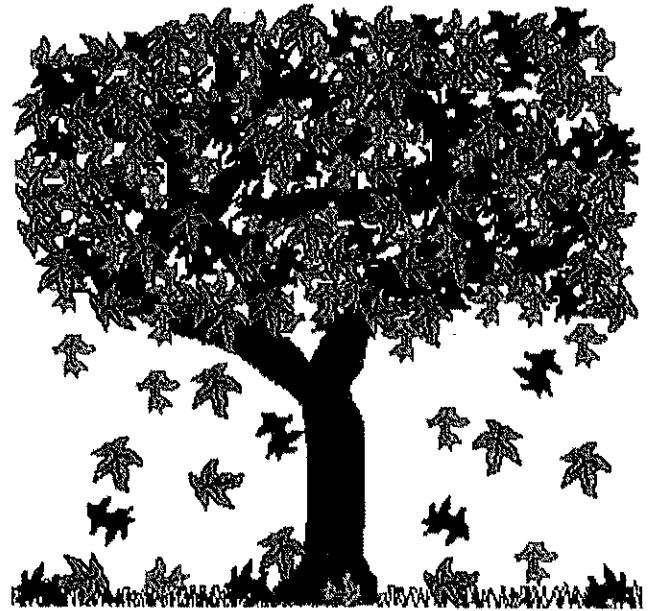

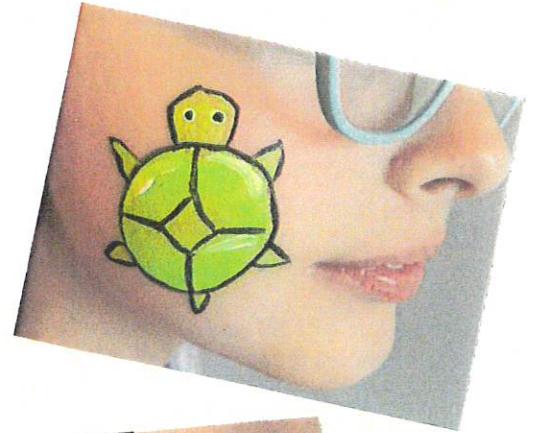
Stewardship Moment
